

Covid-19 Protocols

Infection control has always been a top priority for our practice and you may have seen this during your visits to our office. Our infection control processes are made so that when you receive care, it's both safe and comfortable. We want to tell you about the infection control procedures we follow in our practice to keep patients and staff safe.

Our office follows infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association (ADA), the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). We follow the activities of these agencies so that we are up-to-date on any new rulings or guidance that may be issued. We do this to make sure that our infection control procedures are current and adhere to each agencies' recommendations.

You may see some changes when it is time for your next appointment. We made these changes to help protect our patients and staff.

- We ask that you reschedule your appointment if anyone in your household has had Covid-19 within the last two weeks or if you have been in contact with someone who has had Covid-19.
- Please call the office when you arrive (Collegeville 610-489-6032 and Gilbertsville 484-945-0336) and if we are ready for you, we will ask you to come into the office. If we are not ready, we will ask you to wait in your car and we will call you as soon as your chair is available to you.
- We will be asking everyone that enters the office to wear a mask at all times inside the building.
- Everyone that enters the office will have their temperature taken. If the temperature is over 100.1 we will be asking you to reschedule your appointment.
- We are trying to limit the number of people entering our building, so if your child can come into their appointment alone that would be appreciated. If you prefer to join them, we just ask that you wear a mask at all times and we will be taking your temperature.
- Please use hand sanitizer when you enter the office.
- During this time, our toothbrushing area is closed. We ask that you brush your teeth before your appointment.
